

Defiant Battles Contained In Tin

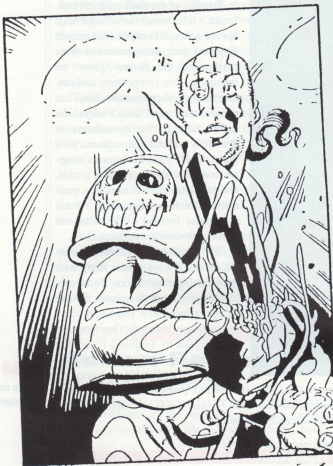
Two Tin Sets From The River Group
